








Disposable masks will be provided if necessary</p> <p><i>Exemptions:</i> Children under 2 & those with medical conditions. Adults with exemptions will be provided a face shield to wear for the service.</p> <p>→</p>
 <p>ARRIVAL</p>	<p>New Entrance Enter the church through the newly marked entrance (to left of the main doors)</p> <p>→</p> <p>*Those with accessibility requirements may enter through the main doors.</p>	 <p>HAND SANITIZER</p>	<p>Hand Washing & Sanitizing Everyone must use provided hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the building.</p> <p>→</p>
 <p>CHECK-IN</p>	<p>Check-in & Seating Volunteers will assist you with check-in and direct you to a seat. Once seated, please do not change seats. Cloakroom will be closed off</p> <p>→</p>		<p>Social Distancing Physical distancing must be maintained at all times unless from the same household or social circle</p> <p>→</p>
 <p>WASHROOM</p>	<p>Washrooms Volunteers will be assigned to clean and disinfect washrooms between each use. Proper handwashing signage will be posted</p> <p>→</p>	 <p>SERVICE</p>	<p>Changes to Service</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No bulletin - No singing - No passing of Communion - No passing of Collection plate - No Meet & Greet w/ Minister - No Sunday School - No Fellowship following service - No shaking hands, hugging or touching <p>→</p>
 <p>EXITING</p>	<p>After Service Volunteers will dismiss attendees row-by-row, beginning with the back row. You will leave the Sanctuary via the kitchen, and exit the Church through the main door.</p> <p>→</p> <p>*Those with mobility issues, or those wearing only a face shield will leave via the stained-glass doors.</p>		<p>Important Information In the event of a confirmed case of COVID-19 at the Church, Ottawa Public Health (OPH) will be provided Contact Tracing info (acquired at registration).</p> <p>Individuals that may have been exposed will be contacted by OPH. Info will also be posted on our website.</p> <p><i>BUC will close for a period of at least 14 days after the outbreak.</i></p>
